COMPETITION OVERVIEW

PHR will host 4 events in a season (1 year timeframe). For each event 3-4 teams (of two members per team) will compete against each other for the TOP HAWG award (i.e., team with the most total points of the 3 competitions). At the end of the season, the team with the highest point total from the 4 events will be crowned the TOP HAWG GRAND CHAMPION. Each team will hunt together, shoot together, and cook together. The TOP HAWG GRAND CHAMPIONS will receive a nice prize in addition to their trophies/awards.

Team entry fees are \$3,000 per team donation (**PHR is a 501c3 and donations are Tax Deductible**). This includes meals and accommodations at the lodge. Team sponsors will receive plaques and any awards the team wins during the competition. We will also interview each team for social media posts and promote their corporate sponsor. All excess hog meat will be processed and donated to local families.

SHOOT SCORING

Each team (2 members per team) will have 45 minutes at the gun range to zero their weapons upon arrival to PHR. For the competition, each team gets 6 shots (3 for each team member) at each target. The table below shows the target distance and point allocation at each distance. Teams will be shooting at 10-inch round gong targets. Teams can use range finders during competition, but must judge wind speed and wind direction the old school way. Sand bags will be provided for shooters.

HUNT SCORING

Each team will hunt at a designated stand each evening. Stand locations will be chosen in a draft format prior to each day of the hunting competition. Teams will be able to scout the designated stands prior to stand selection. Game trail photos will be provided for each of the stands (photos for the 4 previous days of the competition will be provided).

For the 1st hunt of the competition, stand selection order will be randomly drawn. For the 2nd hunt of the competition, stand selection order will be determined based on team points from the 1st day of the hunt competition. Specifically, the team with the lowest 1st day hunting points will select first and the team with the highest point total will select last. Designated hunting times will be provided prior to each hunt. Hunters will be able to hunt at night. Hunters can use a headlight, thermal, or light enhancement device carried on the person for the hunts. The table below shows the points awarded for each animal harvested.



Hog Weight	Point Per Hog
Less than 25 pounds	0
25 to 99 pounds	200
100 to 199 pounds	400
200 pounds or more	600
Heaviest hog bonus	200
Coyote bonus	200 points per coyote
Un-recovered hog	100 point deduction per hog

COOK SCORING

Each team must use the wild hog they harvested during the Hunt competition. The team can use any part of the hog they choose. The hog has to be the main ingredient for the dish they prepare. There are no limitations on the type of dish. Each team must prepare enough food for 50 people (i.e., judges from the local community) to try as part of the competition. Each judge will get one vote for their favorite dish/preparation. The table below shows the points awarded for the cook competition.



Teams will have access to a propane grill, propane griddle, oven, stove, microwave, electric smoker, fire pit, and cooking utensils. Teams must submit a list of cooking ingredients and special requests 5 days prior to the competition. All ingredients will be purchased and available to each team upon arrival.

PHR TOP HAWG AWARDS

PHR will host 4 Top Hawg events each year. Below is a list of awards for each individual event:

- PHR Top Hawg (team with the most total points)
- PHR Hawgzilla Award (heaviest hog harvested during the event)
- PHR Hawgkillla Award (most hogs harvested during the event)
- PHR Top Hawg Chef Award (winner of the cooking competition – most votes)
- PHR Hawg Sniper Award (winner of the shooting competition – most points)

PHR Annual Award (winners for the annual competition)

- PHR Top Hawg Grand Champion (highest point total for the year)
- PHR Hawg Sniper Champion (highest point for the year in the shooting competition)
